- When Ava said, "You're doing it again," what did she mean (page 33)?
- Do you think Beatrice will really try to be more thoughtful about her words?

### Chapter 5

- Have you ever been "the new kid" (at school, at church, on a sports team)? How did that feel?
- Why do you think Willow is being unkind to Beatrice?
- Why did Ava turn red (page 44)?

### Chapter 6

- What was the most interesting thing you learned from the bee video?
- Why did Brady run away from Beatrice?
- Tell how the short phrases describing the accident (page 53) make you feel. Do you think the scene would feel different if the author used complete sentences here?
